		National visa application form: Each applicant must complete and sign a visa application, filling in each of its sections. If the applicant is a minor, both of their parents or a duly accredited representative must sign the application.
		Valid, unexpired passport. Original and a photocopy of the page or pages of the passport that contain biometric data. The passport must have a <u>minimum validity period of 1 year</u> and contain two blank pages. Passports issued more than 10 years ago will not be accepted.
		Previous Passports.
		Legalized and translated Shenاسnameh: (Spanish translation for the last 6 month). For all the family members. If anyone has been born in Spain, he/she should provide it.
		Photograph: A recent, 3.5*4.5,(for the last 3 month) color photograph,, taken against a light background, facing forward, without dark or reflective glasses, or any garments concealing the oval of the face.
		Medical certificate: (for the last 3 month) Applicants requiring a visa for a stay of more than 180 days must submit the original and a copy of a medical certificate accrediting that they do not suffer from any disease that could cause serious repercussions for public health pursuant to the 2005 International Health Regulations. Foreign documents must be legalized or apostilled and, where applicable, must be submitted together with an official translation into Spanish.
		From Spain: copy of “Autorización de Residencia Temporal por Reagrupación Familiar” issued by “Delegación o Subdelegación del Gobierno”.
		Criminal record check certificate. (for the last 3 month): Applicants of legal age who apply for a visa for a stay of more than 180 days must submit the original and a copy of the criminal record check certificate(s) issued by their country or countries of residence for the past 5 years. Foreign documents must be legalized or apostilled and, where applicable, must be submitted together with an official translation into Spanish.
		Documents proving family relationship with the applicant. a) Marriage certificate for the spouse. In the event of second or successive marriage, proof of divorce from the previous spouse. b) Birth certificates for children.
