Long-term residence or EU long-term residence recovery visa

To obtain a long-term resident or EU long-term resident recovery visa it is first necessary to submit an application to recover the permit. For this reason, the procedure has two stages. For the first stage, the applicant must contact the Spanish Embassy

Second stage. Further to your application for a LONG-TERM RESIDENCE RECOVERY VISA we list below the documents that have to be submitted.

National visa application form Each applicant must complete and sign a visa application, filling in each of its sections. If the applicant is a minor, both of their parents or a duly accredited representative must sign the application.
Valid, unexpired passport. Original and a photocopy of the page or pages of the passport that contain biometric data. The passport must have a minimum validity period of 1 year and contain two blank pages. Passports issued more than 10 years ago will not be accepted.
*Photograph: A recent, 3.5*4.5, (for the last 3 month) color photograph,, taken against a light background, facing forward, without dark or reflective glasses, or any garments concealing the oval of the face.
*Legalized and translated Shenasnameh (Spanish translation for the last 6 month): For all the family members. If anyone has been born in Spain, he/she should provide it.
Residence permit. Original and a copy of the favourable decision recognizing recovery of the long-term residence permit or EU long-term residence permit
Proof of residence in the consular district (only for non Iranian nationals).
